Washington Class of 1954; Allen University in the Class of 1958 (received her B.S. degree in Education). She earned her Masters degree from the University of Southern California and was working on her doctorate at the University of South Carolina in human resources Management.

She was a life long member and served as organist at Chappelle Memorial AME Church. Her missionary experiences early in life contributed to a life long passion with international endeavors. In her spare time, she was a world traveler, art collector, reader and musician.

She was employed with the Department of State, United States of America and received meritorious Honor Award for sustained outstanding performance, dedication and customer service as the Head of Consular Section Operation in Monrovia Liberia from 2000 to 2002; US Department of State Bureau of Consular Affairs in recognition of her dedication and commitment to excellence in serving on the Passport Taskforce; Department of State United States of America in recognition of 20 years of service and dedication to the government of the United States; Alexandria Commission for Women, Alexandria, VA. She completed two overseas tours of duty as a Foreign

Service Officer in the Consular Section of Kingston, Seoul, Monrovia, Liberia and Kingston, Jamaica

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Samuel Preston Bouie.
