Albert Gordon, Jr., 41, departed this earthly life and slipped into a peaceful rest on Monday July 7, 2014 at the Carolina Medical Center in Charlotte, NC. Born in Sumter County on August 25, 1972, he was the first son of Martha Dukes Gordon and the late Albert Gordon, Sr.

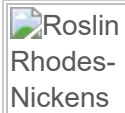
