Allen Eleazer, Jr. departed this life on Sunday, January 30, 2022 at Heartland Rehabilitation, Columbia, SC. Allen was the third of five children born to the late Allen Eleazer, Sr. and Bennie Mae Wise Eleazer on September 29, 1950. Allen graduated from Fitch High School in 1969, where he was a decorated athlete lettering in four sports: track, basketball, football, and baseball. Shortly after high school, Allen was drafted into the United States Army. An accomplished serviceman, Allen received the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with two Bronze Service Stars, and two marksmanship badges: Sharpshooter (Rifle M-16) and Expert (M60 MG). After serving honorably in the military, Allen was employed by the Monsanto Company in Deep River, Connecticut before relocating to Columbia, South Carolina in 1986. In Columbia, he was employed by the City of Columbia in various capacities, including as a business license specialist until his retirement in January 2011.

Allen was blessed with a large and loving family, who affectionately referred to him as "Bro Al." He met his soulmate, Vera Gordon, in 1991 in Columbia, South Carolina, and they were united in holy matrimony on September 27, 1996. Together they enjoyed Washington D.C. In his free time, Allen loved to fish, tinker with his motorcycle, and spend time with his grandchildren, who he adored.
