Annie Mae Fleming Carter, wife of Robert Foster Carter, Jr., departed this earthly life and entered into eternal rest on Friday, June 26, 2020, at Prisma Health Richland Hospital, Columbia, South Carolina. She was born September 19, 1945, in Sumter, South Carolina, and was the only daughter and heart string of the late Willie Fleming and Eva Butler Fleming.

At an early age, she accepted Christ and became a member of Mechanicsville United Methodist Church. After uniting in holy matrimony, she joined her husband at Unionville African Methodist Episcopal Church, St. Charles, South Carolina.
