Beaufort Pogue, Jr., 80, husband of Patricia Jean Buckner Pogue, died Wednesday, May 8, 2013 at his residence in Sumter. Born in Sumter County, he was the son of the late Beaufort Pogue, Sr. and Katie Blackwell-Pogue. Beaufort received his education in the public schools of Sumter County. He later joined the United States Air Force and served for 22 years until his retirement.
