November 23, 1943 - February 18, 2020

On Tuesday, February 18, 2020, Bryne Rosalyn Singleton Sumter took her last breathe at Providence Hospital in Columbia, South Carolina. Born in Wilmington, North Carolina, she was the daughter of the late Benjamin Earl Singleton and Clara Juanita Medley Singleton and was later adopted by the late Ben and Lavinia Sumter.

The oldest of three children, Bryne was an exceptional student. She graduated from Lincoln High School and went on to earn a Masters of Science in Mathematics from South Carolina State University. She was a dedicated high school educator and accomplished seamstress with an attentive eye for detail. Her greatest joy was sharing her creative sewing and homemaking abilities with her daughter and grandchildren.
