From early on he had a passion for art, loving to draw, music, playing four instruments, and basketball. When it came to basketball, he was a powerhouse. While attending Socastee High School he scored the winning shot against Myrtle Beach and while attending Myrtle Beach he scored the winning shot against Socastee High School, winning not one but two state championships. He even played against NBA basketball player Rasheed Wallace in the Beach Ball Classic and beat him. He did face many trials though leading him to become incarcerated. He did not let that stop him though. contact with his family he would frequently send home drawings that he had made with words of encouragement. He faithfully attended church every Sunday that he could and earned his certificate for commissary. He did not allow his trials to define him. Upon his release in March of 2023 he set of to write his redemption story(after getting his McDonald's ice cream). He got his driver's license, purchased a car, finished writing his book, and September of 2023 he got married. His greatest accomplishments and pride and joy though was connecting with his

daughter, and hugging his mom again.

Carlos's life was cut short on March 16th, 2024 at 6:15 am., when he was hit and killed by a car.
