Mrs. Carrie Milledge Patterson, 85, daughter of the late Reverend Frederick Milledge and Reverend Mrs. Mary Millege, went to be with the Lord on Thursday, August 28, 2014. Born in Augusta, Georgia, Mrs. Patterson was raised in Columbia, South Carolina and was married to the late William Bradford Patterson, Sr. Born to this marriage were five beautiful children.

Mrs. Patterson graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in 1946 and Columbia Hospital School of Nursing (now Palmetto Health Richland) as a registered nurse in 1949. During her 29 years of nursing, she worked at Crafts Farrow State Hospital (Hall Institute) as a nursing supervisor, also worked at the Old Columbia Hospital (now RMH), and later retired from Moncrief Army Hospital, Fort Jackson.

She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, aunt, cousin and was so very loved by everyone she knew and came in contact with.
