his journey bringing so much love and completion in his life.

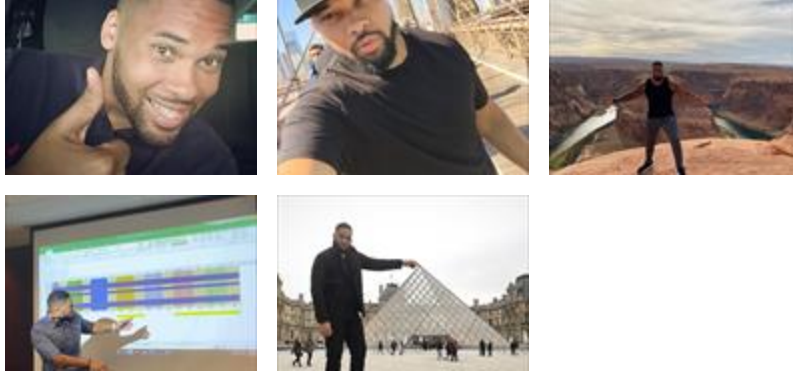
