Charlie Frierson, Jr., 64, died Thursday, July 25, 2013 at the Tuomey Healthcare System in Sumter, SC. Born in Sumter County, he was a son of the late Charlie and Atha Brogdon Frierson.

He was educated in the public schools of Sumter County and was a graduate of Eastern High School, Class of 1968. As a child, he attended the St. Paul AME Church in Sumter and later joined the Congruity Presbyterian Church, (USA) of Gable, SC. In 1968, he enlisted in the United State Army and served a tour of duty in Vietnam. After wards, he moved to Washington, DC and began a career with the United States Postal Service. After his retirement in 2005, he returned home to reside in Sumter.
