Clarence Martin Pope, III, 44, husband of Kemyatta Cash Pope, departed this earthly life on November 10, 2015 at his residence in Mauldin, South Carolina. Born in Oceanside, New York, he was the youngest of four children born to Norma Wileeta Brown Pope and the late Dr. Clarence Martin Pope, II.

Raised in Freeport, New York, Clarence graduated from St. Andrews Preparatory School in the Class of 1988. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Fisk University and graduated in the Class of 1995. Clarence was a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. He was employed as an engineer at Bavarian Motor Works in Greenville, South Carolina for over 15 years. He was an avid tennis player and at the age of 14, won the US Open Junior Championship. Clarence was dedicated to his children, enjoyed high performance luxury vehicles and was devoted to his bulldogs, Buster, Brooklyn and Noah. Clarence was a private man, gone too soon. 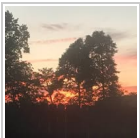
