



## Edith Monroe Smith

August 16, 1940 - April 29, 2013

Mrs. Edith Monroe Smith, 72, wife of the late John Lee Smith, died Monday, April 29, 2013, at her residence in Sumter. Born in Clarendon County, she was the daughter of the late Jesse Monroe and Dorothy Smith Monroe.

She attended the public schools of Sumter County and was a graduate of Lincoln High School, class of 1959. Edith joined the Second Presbyterian Church, USA at an early age, where she faithfully served on the Usher Board and the Food Ministry.
