Elizabeth Christine Holland Jennings, 84, wife of the late John Franklin Jennings, died Saturday, September 7, 2013 at the Tuomey Healthcare System in Sumter. Born in Columbus, Ohio, she was the daughter of the late John H. Jones and Kathryn Holland Jones.

She was educated in the public schools of Columbus Ohio and completed high school in West Virginia. In 1962, she enlisted in the United States Army and served eight years with the final rank of a Staff Sargent. During her military tour of duty, she was honored as the grand matron of the Eastern Star in Munich Germany and was employed with Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, MD. After retiring from the military she and her family relocated to Sumter. Elizabeth joined the Mt. Calvary Baptist and served faithfully in many capacities.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, John F. Jennings.
