Mr. Ernest Herman Hogan was born July 27, 1934 in Daytona Beach FL. He was the son of the late Mr. Samuel Hogan and Mrs. Ernestine Birch Hogan. He departed this life on March 31, 2015 at Providence Hospital. He is preceded in death by his late wife Vera Mae Hall Hogan and daughter, Rhonda Gail Williams (Warren).

He attended school at Campbell Street High in Daytona Beach and continued his education at Midlands Technical College where he earned an Associate’s Degree in Business.
