Mrs. Flossie Carter was born October 12, 1923, in Oswego (Sumter County), South Carolina, now Dalzell, South Carolina. She was the 6th child born to the late Mr. Warden McGee, Sr. and Mrs. Mamie Porter McGee.

She completed high school at Coulter Memorial Academy and received her B.A. degree from Morris College in Sumter, South Carolina. While attending Harbison Junior College, she met and married the love of her life, Earnest Leroy Carter. Married on June 4, 1947, the couple remained happily married for 47 years until his death.

Mrs. Carter worked in the Augusta School district for a short period of time prior to transferring to Lexington County School District #4. She served as an elementary school teacher at the formally known Monroe Pinckney Elementary School and then at Swansea Elementary School where she was selected Teacher of the Year. Mrs. Carter retired after 30 years of service.

Mrs. Carter was a life-long member of Mt. Pisgah AME Church where she served as a stewardess, Sunday School superintendent and teacher, and a Pull-Together Club member in addition to being a member of the choir. One of her most cherished memories is the church named her the 2012 Woman of the Year honoree.

Mrs. Carter leaves to cherish precious memories her 5 children: Earnestine Carter Holden, James Arnold (Shirley) Carter, Edward Leroy (Glenda) Carter, Sandrel Carter (Harold) Jackson, and John Casper (Helen) Carter; 11 grandchildren; 3 great-grandchildren; 1 sister Emma McGee (Timothy) Pearson; 1 brother Albertus McGee; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends including her former Harbison roommate and friend, Mrs. Ruby Dillard.
