



Rev. Jacobas Mitchell

November 26, 1934 - July 25, 2014

Rev. Jacobas Mitchell was called from labor to reward on July 25, 2014, at the St. Luke Roosevelt Hospital in New York, NY. Born in Charleston, SC on November 26, 1934, he was a son of the late Robert Lee Mitchell and Carrie Mitchell and the husband of the late Clara Evans Mitchell.

Rev. Mitchell was educated in the Charleston, SC Public School System. He accepted Christ at an early age and became a member of Morris Brown A.M. E. Church Charleston. As a youth he was very active in several areas of church activities. He served as a Class Leader, an Usher, Sunday School Teacher and Assistant director of the Youth and Boys Choirs. He also served as President of the Allen Christian Endeavor League and produced many plays and other programs.

In 1958 Rev. Mitchell moved to New York City and joined St. Luke A.M.E. Church

under the Pastorate of the late A.A. Davis. In 1966 , he joined Metropolitan A.M. E. Church and in July 1978, he met the love of his life and best friend, the late Sis. Clara Evans. They were joined in holy matrimony in May 1980 and celebrated thirty two wonderful years together of a God ordained marriage.

It was also at Metropolitan in 1982, under the Pastorate of Rev. Simon P. Bouie, that Rev. Mitchell was called into this glorious awesome Ministry of Preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

On January 19th, 1991, Rev. Mitchell was appointed Pastor of Turner

Memorial A.M.E. Church in Harlem, NY. He served Turner Memorial with dedication and distinction for 18 1/2 years before retiring from the active Pastoral Ministry in April 2009.

In July 2009, Rev Mitchell became a member of the Ministerial Staff of St. Luke, A.M.E. Church, where he continued to proclaim the Word of God (whenever called upon) and taught one of four weekly Bible Studies.

Rev. Mitchell's favorite hymns were: "O Thou In Whose Presence" and "O For A Closer Walk With God." His favorite Scripture was 121st Psalm.

He leaves to cherish his precious memories, one brother Harold Mitchell of New York; eight sisters and brothers- in-Law, Tena (Cleveland) Jenkins , Georgia (Carrell) Evans, all of New York; Genet (Freddie) Fulwood of Baltimore, MD, Audrey (Herbert) McCoy, of South Carolina; a host of nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral Services will be held, 12:00 noon, Friday, August 1, 2014 at Mt. Sinai A.M.E. Church, 4835 County Road, 43-59 Lynchburg, South Carolina with Pastor Marie Webb officiating. Interment will follow in the Edwards Cemtery, Lynchburg, SC. The public may view on Thursday, July 31, 2014 at the Palmer Memorial Chapel, Inc.,from 4:30 -8:00 pm, 304 South Main St., Sumter. Rev.
