Affectionately known as Venetia, she was educated in the public schools of Richland County, graduating from CA Johnson High School in 1957, and attended Benedict College as a Nursing major.

Mrs. Hammonds was employed as a Certified Nursing Assistant at the SC Department of Mental Health, at CM Tucker Nursing Care Center and Brian Psychiatric Hospital, where she retired in 2001.
