On May 20, 2023, Joann Isaac transitioned from labor to reward. She rejoiced in advance knowing that she would see Jesus her Savior. She dedicated her life as a servant knowing the responsibility to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ to everyone. Her deepest passion was for the children of generations to come.

Joann was born on August 13, 1944. She was the daughter of Beatrice Lide and stepdaughter of Roscoe Lide, Sr. and father, William Isaac. She was educated in Richland County public schools and was a graduate of C.A. Johnson High School Class of 1962.

Joann worked as a manager of Macy's children's department for many years and later at the University of South Carolina in the Marine Science program where she would retire.

Joann's zeal for God was infectious and everyone around her could feel her genuine love for God and mankind. She was the teacher for "The New Life" orientation class. Her anointed teaching gift was always evident at Young's Chapel Baptist church and Haskell Heights First Baptist church. She touched many, many lives over the years.
