

## John Darrell Moultrie

August 6, 1967 - August 11, 2020

On Tuesday, August 11, 2020, John Darrell Moultrie went home to be with the Lord. Born August 6, 1967, in Sumter, South Carolina, he was the son of the late John James and Deloris Moultrie.

Educated in the public schools of Richland County, Darrell was a 1985 graduate of Columbia High School. After graduation, he enlisted in the United States Navy, serving honorably until his discharge for medical disability.

A lifelong member of Jones Tabernacle Fire Baptize Holiness Church, Darrell served in numerous capacities: Choir; Young People's Institute (YPI); Holy Young People's Union (HYPU); actor in church plays; and performance of Monologues. In later years, he attended Atmosphere Christian Center Church.

Darrell had varied interests. He enjoyed cooking, staging and taking pictures of his meals, and texting them to his family and friends. Darrell was also a fan of monologues and spoken word, often citing James Weldon Johnson as an inspiration and frequently quoting him in text messages or Facebook posts to uplift others.

In addition to his parents, Darrell was preceded in death by numerous ancestors.

He leaves to cherish precious memories his sisters: Deborah Moultrie and Patricia Ann James; his brother: Lawrence James; his cousin, raised in the home as a sibling, Brittany Moultrie (Admer) Prophet and their daughter Miracle Moultrie; two aunts: Lila Pauling and Louise Clea-Washington; three uncles: George James, Leroy James, and Samuel James; special cousins: Gwendolyn Bouie and Evyett Clea-Henderson; a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends.

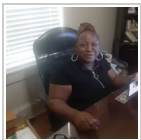
