Mr. Joseph Terry Johnson was born on January 26, 1956 in Sumter, S.C. Affectionately known as “Binky,” he was the son of John K. and Thelma Huggins Johnson. He entered into eternal rest on Monday, August 18, 2014 at Elmhurst Hospital in Elmhurst, N.Y.
