



## Mr. Larry Delane Tucker Sr.

On Tuesday, September 5, 2023 at Lexington Medical Center, Larry Delane Tucker transitioned into glory to be with his Lord & Savior Jesus Christ and with those who went on before him. Larry was born September 11, 1949 in Columbia, SC to Robert Lee & Arnetha Norris Tucker.

Larry was a graduate of Booker T. Washington High School Class of 1967. After graduation, Larry's mentor & scout master Ruty Bookard was instrumental in introducing him to the US Marine Corps. He was a proud Marine who served his country during the Vietnam War Era.

For forty-four (44) years he was employed as a Nuclear Fuel Operator at Westinghouse Nuclear Fuel Division.

After his retirement, he joined the South Carolina Combat Veterans Group. For many years through his Veteran's Group, he served as a mentor to 3rd and 4th grade boys at Hyatt Park Elementary School which he enjoyed immensely.
