Lincoln Conwell Brock, Sr., husband of Ruth Thompson Brock, died Saturday, October 12, 2013 at the Family Residential Care Facility in Sumter. Born in Clarendon County, he was a son of the late Rev. Luther Brock and Carrie Mack Brock.

Mr. Brock was a lifelong member of St. Matthews Missionary Baptist Church, where he served as a deacon for over 55 years and served as chairman of the Deacon Board for 33 years. He was a member of the Male Chorus and the Royal Traveleers Quartet. He was the owner and operator of Lincoln Brock Building and Repairs.

In addition to his parents , he was preceded in death by sons; Lincoln Brock, Jr., John L. Brock and Jimmy Harvin, Sr.; four brothers, Martin Luther, John E. , James A. and Russell Brock; two sisters, Mella Mae Alston and Inez B. Goodman.
