Mildred Frances Suber Murray wife of the late Charlie Murray Sr. transitioned on Monday, July 11, 2022 at her residence in Columbia, South Carolina. Born on April 14, 1929 in Newberry, South Carolina she was a daughter of the late Willie Suber and Dollie Bowman Suber.

Educated in the public schools of Newberry County she attended Voorhees College and Allen University earning a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education. She received her Master of Science in Elementary Education from S.C. State University. Early in her teaching career she married Willis C. Belton and to this loving union one daughter, Cassandra, was born.

Mrs. Murray taught for thirty-eight (38) years in the elementary schools of Newberry, Fairfield and Richland counties. She was a teacher at Windsor Elementary School, Richland School District Two when she retired. Her love of teaching extended beyond the classroom as she was always teaching and sharing her knowledge with others.

Mildred was a faithful member of St. Luke Episcopal Church. She served on the Vestry, Episcopal Church Women (ECW), William F.
