While at Mather Academy Mildred met the love of her life her husband James F. Page Sr. James and Mildred were blessed with two beautiful children, James Jr. and Persephone. They were blessed to share 26 wonderful years.

After marriage Mildred joined Chappelle Memorial AME Church where she served as a faithful member for over fifty years. Mildred faithfully served her church in a variety of capacities; the Chancel Choir, Steward Board, Stewardess #1, Debs and Master's Program, Class Leader #9, Finance Committee and Woman of the Year 2002. She also served as the Chair of the Grandparents Day Committee that provided a token of appreciation and recognition to all grandparents of the church every year. organization that provided scholarships and service to those in need. For years she served as treasurer of the MLK Neighborhood Association that worked to improve the park and surrounding community.
