Mrs. Queen Esther Hart Hentz was born in 1921 in Florence, SC. She transitioned September 21, 2020.

She dedicated her life to Christ at an early age. She was long-time member of Saint James AME Church in Pomaria, SC, where she served as secretary. In her later years, she joined Reid Chapel AME Church in Columbia where she was active in the Senior Citizens Club, Missionary Society, Pulpit Aid and Stewardess Board Number 1.

She was a graduate of Columbia Hospital School of Nursing, Class of 1945. She worked as a RN, Operating Room Scrub Nurse and Supervisor at Columbia Hospital. Her specialty was neurosurgery. She ended her career at Richland Memorial Hospital in 1985 after 40 years of service. During her nursing career, she touched the lives of many people and remained enthusiastic about nursing and caring for others throughout her career. She was the epitome of professionalism and black excellence. At the celebration of her 35 years of service she was called an “‘institution’ at the institution.”

Queen was an active member of Chi Eta Phi, International Nursing Sorority, Delta Eta Chapter, and the Columbia Hospital Nursing Alumni Association, in Columbia. She served as treasurer for both organizations for many years. The sorority honored her as the 1986 Outstanding Contributor to Nursing.

She was preceded by her husband, Joseph Hentz.
