Rashaad Ragin, 25, transitioned on Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at Prisma Health Richland in Columbia, South Carolina. Born in Sumter County, he was the youngest son born to Minister Lester and Rosa Wactor Ragin. He was a lifelong member of St. Matthews Missionary Baptist Church of Sumter.
