Richard B. Felton, Jr., was born June 27, 1935. He was the first child born to the late Richard Felton, Sr. and the late Elnora White Felton.

At an early age, he accepted Christ in his life as he joined Hopewell Baptist Church. Richard attended Mary E. Graham elementary and high school. He continued his education at Midlands Technical College in Columbia, South Carolina.

He joined the U.S. Navy where he was on active duty. Richard retired as a postal clerk from the U.S. Navy after 22 years of service.
