Retired Sgt. First Class Robert Lee Barnett, was born April 3, 1927, in Hattiesburg, Mississippi. He passed away, Sunday, November 3, 2013 at Warriors Walk: Hospice and Palliative Care Unit of W.J. Bryan Dorn Veterans Hospital.

He was educated in the public schools of Hattiesburg and Gulfport, Mississippi. His entry into the United States Army was at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, October 27, 1945. His honorable discharge was at Fort Jackson, Columbia, South Carolina, on September 30, 1970.

Service tours of Duty include the United States, World War II, Era, Germany, Korea, Alaska, Hawaii and Vietnam. He was the recipient of the Good Conduct Medal (6th Award); two O/5 Bars; Bronze Star medal; Vietnam Commendation Medal w/device 60; and Vietnam Service Medal.
