Sandy Haynes, son of the late Annie Legree Haynes and the late Eddie Haynes of Moncks Corner, was born Jan. 7, 1935. After graduating from Berkeley Training School, he moved to Brooklyn, NY, where he met and married his wife, Mildred Whitney. The family relocated to Columbia in 1975, where for 35 years he worked as an independent long-distance truck driver.

For forty years, he was an active member of First Calvary Baptist of Columbia, where he was ordained as a Deacon in 1998, served faithfully in the Prison Ministry, and re-established the Jubilee Choir.

Sandy was taken to his final rest on June 9, 2015. He was preceded in death by his son David Haynes of Columbia; his brother Ervin Haynes of Cocoa Beach, FL; and his sister Yohanna Haynes of Matawan, NJ. He leaves to cherish his memory his wife of 52 years, Mildred Whitney Haynes; daughter Sandi Haynes of Durham, NC; daughter Kimberly (Eddie) Stephens of Columbia; sister Louise Brown of Moncks Corner, SC; and sisters Malgretta Fennick and Queen Haynes of Matawan, NJ.
