



## Theo William Moss Jr

Theo William Moss, Jr., 49, transitioned Sunday, January 20, 2013 at the Golden Living Center in Georgia. Born in Sumter County, he was the son of Frances Clark Moss and the late Theo W. Moss, Sr.

His early education began in the Clarendon and Sumter County Public Schools. He was a graduate of Sumter High School, Class of 1981, and a graduate of the University of South Carolina, Class of 1984. After graduation, Theo began his professional career with the BellSouth Corporation in Atlanta, Georgia and was employed with the Georgia Department of Human Resources as an Epidemiologist for the past ten years.

Theo was a member of the St. Luke Episcopal Church, in Atlanta and was an active member of the Brotherhood of St. Andrew and the Union of Black Episcopalians. He was an active participant in many civic and social organizations, including; The DeKalb County NAACP, The Atlanta Chapter of the National Urban League, University of South Carolina Alumni Association, Jaguar Learning Mentor at Stephenson High School in Stone Mountain Georgia, and the DeKalb Young Democrats.
