



William Davis Jr.

November 30, 1953 - March 11, 2025

Mr. William Davis Jr., 71, passed away peacefully on the evening of Tuesday, March 11, 2025, answering Gods call to eternal rest. He was born on November 30, 1953, in Columbia, South Carolina, the second child of the late William Davis Sr. and Eva Pearl Davis.

William was educated in the public schools of Lexington County and graduated from Brookland-Cayce High School after attending Lakeview High School. He pursued higher education at Benedict College before embarking on a dedicated career with the United States Postal Service, where he served for 47 years. His commitment to his profession led him to become a lifetime member of the National Alliance of Postal and Federal Employees and was honored with the Million Miles Safe Driver Award in the Greater District of Columbia, SC.

In the 1980s, William accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior at Turner Memorial AME Church. He later became an active member of Reid Chapel AME Church, where he faithfully served

numerous ministries, including the Trustee Board, Culinary Ministry, Choir, Usher Board, and Boy Scouts. His powerful rendition of & Rough Side of the Mountain; uplifted many during worship services. As a Boy Scout leader, he believed in guiding young men through their rites of passage. His dedication as a trustee is memorialized on the cornerstone of Reid Chapel AME, dated 1995. In his later years, he continued his faith journey as a devoted member of Bethel AME Church.

William was preceded in death by his parents William Sr and Eva Pearl Davis; his brother, Melvin Davis; and his grandparents.

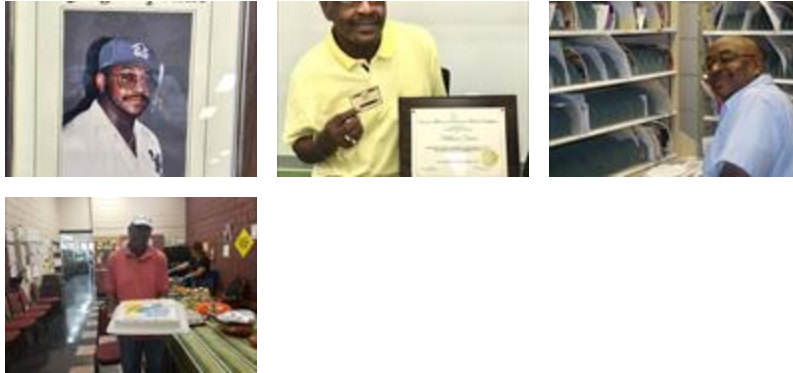

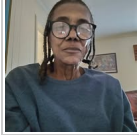
